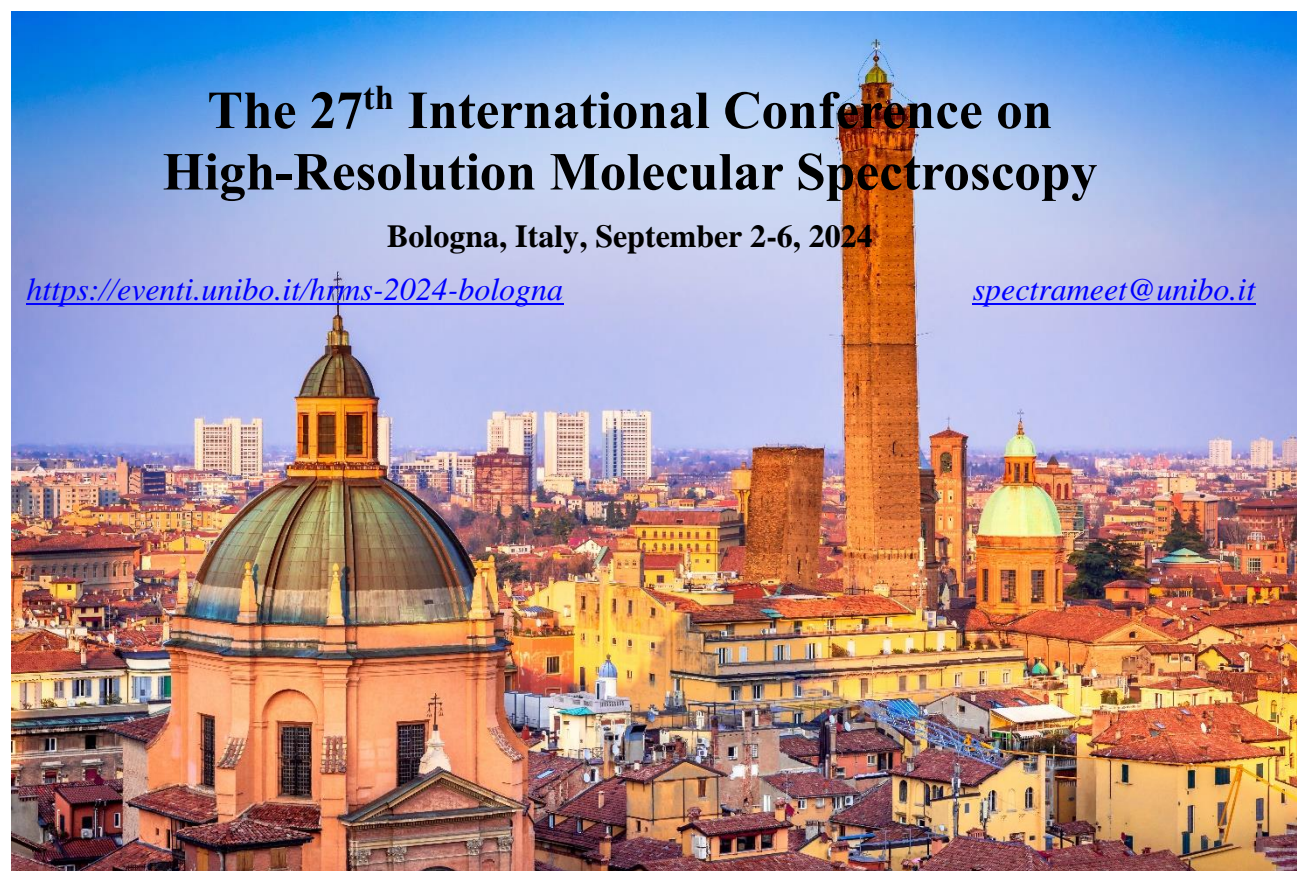

Arrival and registration

Upon your arrival, you can go directly to your hotel or dormitory. Maps showing the location of the university residence are available on this circular and our website (maps #1 and #2).

The conference will take place in the Complesso Belmeloro teaching building located in via B. Andreatta, 8, Bologna, Italy (See Maps #3 & #4).



The registration desk, coffee breaks and sponsor exhibitions will be on the ground floor while the sessions will be held in rooms B, C and D on the first floor.

The registration desk will be open on:

- Sunday, September 1st from 16:30 until 19:30
(food and drinks will be served for an informal Get Together)
- Monday, September 2nd from 8:15 to 12:30
- Throughout the conference during the breaks

How to get to Bologna

Bologna, a road junction of primary importance since Roman times, is today the center of a transport network of vital importance in Italy.

By car

Here is a crossroads of the major motorways linking Europe with the rest of Italy: the A1 (Autostrada del Sole) Milan - Naples; the A13 to Ferrara, Padua, Venice and Trieste and the A14 towards the Adriatic coast (Rimini, Ravenna, Ancona, Bari).

Note that the maximum allowed speed in municipal areas in Italy is 30 or 50 km/h. The maximum allowed speed is 130 km/h on motorways and 70 or 90 km/h on other roads outside municipal areas. Most motorways (autostrada) are subject to toll payments to be made at toll stations.

By train

Bologna is the main Italian railway junction; a high-speed line connects it to Florence (37 minutes), Milan (65 minutes), Rome (2 hours and 22 minutes). Venice can be reached in less than an hour and a half.

By plane

The Guglielmo Marconi International Airport links Bologna with the main Italian and European airports. It is a major airport in Italy for the number of international destinations served, with a runway for flights ranging up to 5 thousand nautical miles and modern technology for safety and environmental protection.

Parking

Bologna is like any big city, parking is difficult but there are many parking places. Parking in the city center is available, many are open 24 hours. One of the biggest parking garages is in Piazza VIII Agosto.

Please note that the conference campus itself is located within a restricted traffic zone and thus cannot be reached by car (**hefty fines are enforced**).

Tickets on train

Train tickets must be purchased **before boarding** and for regional trains you must check-in at least 5 minutes before departure. No tickets are sold in trains and hefty fines are applied if you are found with a not validated train ticket.

Tickets on bus

Bus tickets can be purchased before boarding and validated inside the vehicle or purchased by credit and debit card on the bus (one ticket per card!).

Instructions for authors

The following times are associated with the different types of talk:

Plenary talks: 45 minutes (35' for presentation and 10' for discussion)
Keynote Talks: 30 minutes (25' for presentation and 5' for discussion)
Contributed talks: 15 minutes (12' for presentation and 3' for discussion)

Speakers presenting a talk are requested to arrive at least 30 minutes before the start of their oral session. The use of your own laptop is highly discouraged. Presentation file formats include .pptx and .pdf.

Authors are required to have a copy of their presentation on a USB drive to be able to upload it to the PC of the corresponding session. If you don't have a USB flash drive available, you can send your presentation **by email to spectrameet@unibo.it by the evening before your scheduled talk**. This way, the organizers of the event will have the presentation ready for your presentation slot.

Poster contribution

Poster grids and clips will be located at the conference site
Poster size A0 (portrait orientation) maximum.

Meals

Since a number of participants will be staying at the Residenza in via del Carpentiere where no breakfast is available and this may be the case for other participants, we are happy to offer a light breakfast at the conference site starting from 8:15.

For lunch the Mensa Universitaria, Piazza Puntoni 1, is located 400 m from the Conference Hall. Lunch will be available using the Lunch Tickets (requested upon registration) or at 7-12 €/meal depending on your individual choice.

For supper the Mensa at Ex Scuderie dei Bentivoglio: Piazza Giuseppe Verdi, 2 is open and you can use the Dinner Tickets (also requested upon registration).

The center of Bologna is crowded with small restaurants and bars (where small meals are also served) and we invite you to take the opportunity to explore the beautiful medieval Bologna and the world-famous Emilia-Romagna cuisine ubiquitous in the university district and downtown.

Social program

The Sunday afternoon/evening Get Together, the Social Dinner and the Chamber Concert on Wednesday are included in the registration fees for both the participants and accompanying persons.

On Thursday, an excursion (on foot) to the Sanctuary of San Luca (on top of the “Colle della Guardia”, 280 a.s.l.), one of the symbols of Bologna, is organized. At 17:30, from Porta Saragozza, the walk under the world's longest portico (666 arcades) starts. After ~1.6 km (in about 25 min), along via Saragozza, the Meloncello Arch is reached. From there, the climbing up to the sanctuary begins (~1.9 km, in about 40-45 min). This second part of the walk is quite steep (498 steps) but accessible to everyone (see MAP #5 Excursion to San Luca).

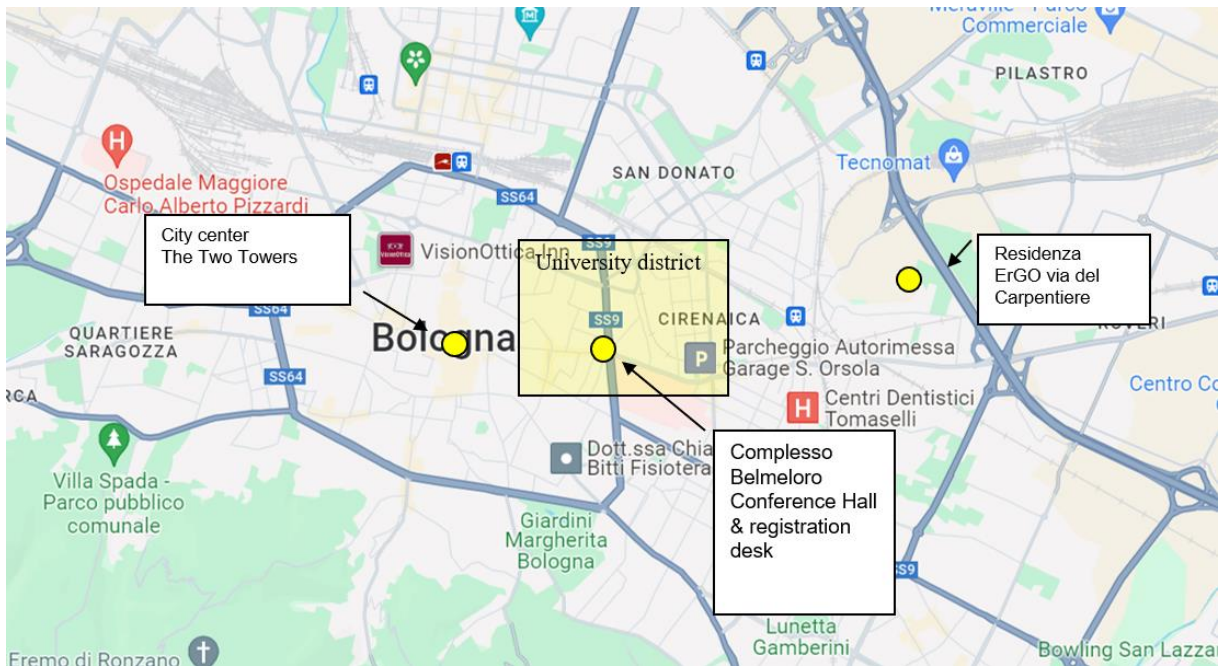

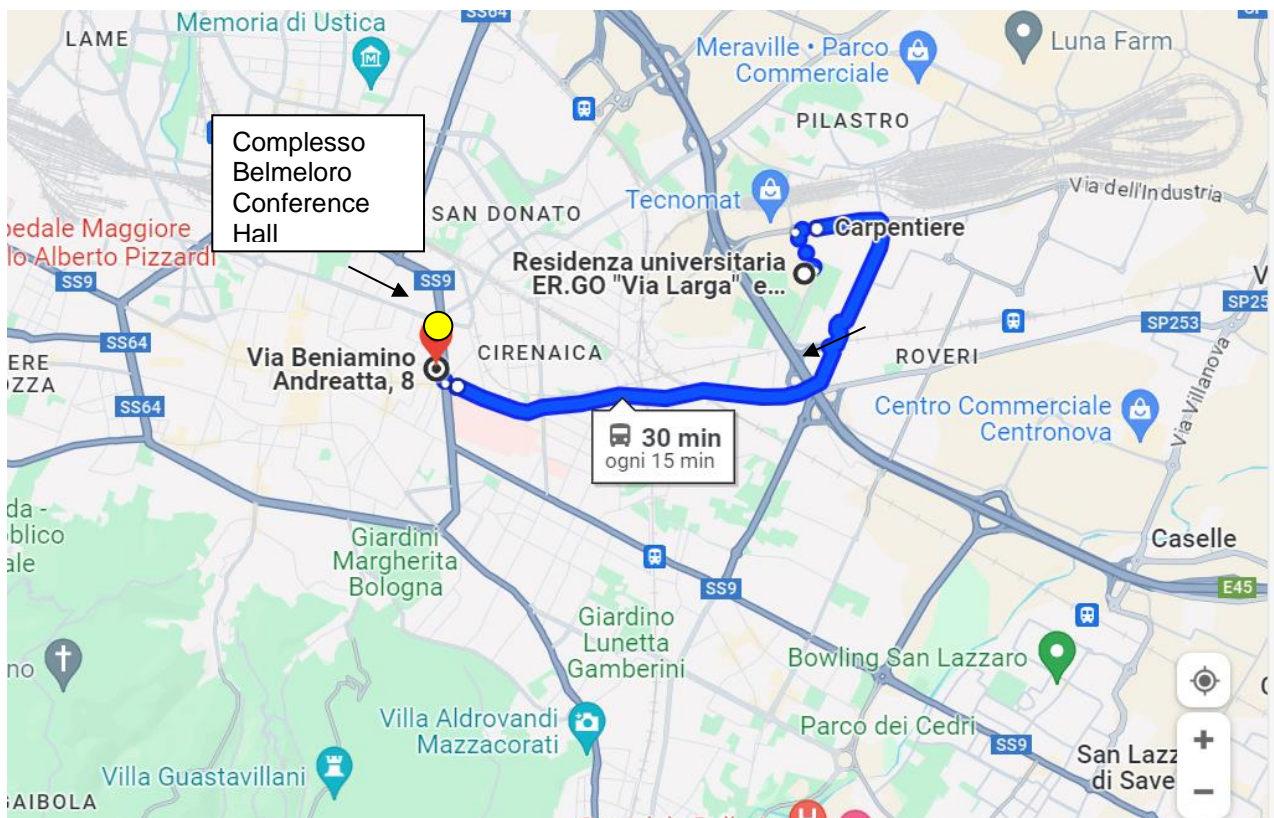

MAP #1 Bologna City Center and Residence

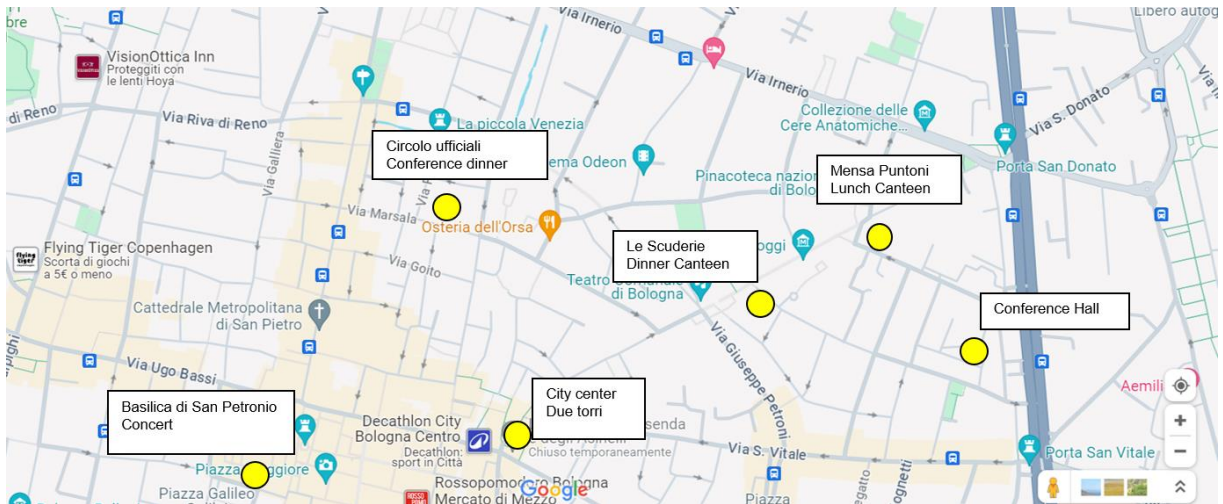


MAP #2 From the Residence to the Conference Hall

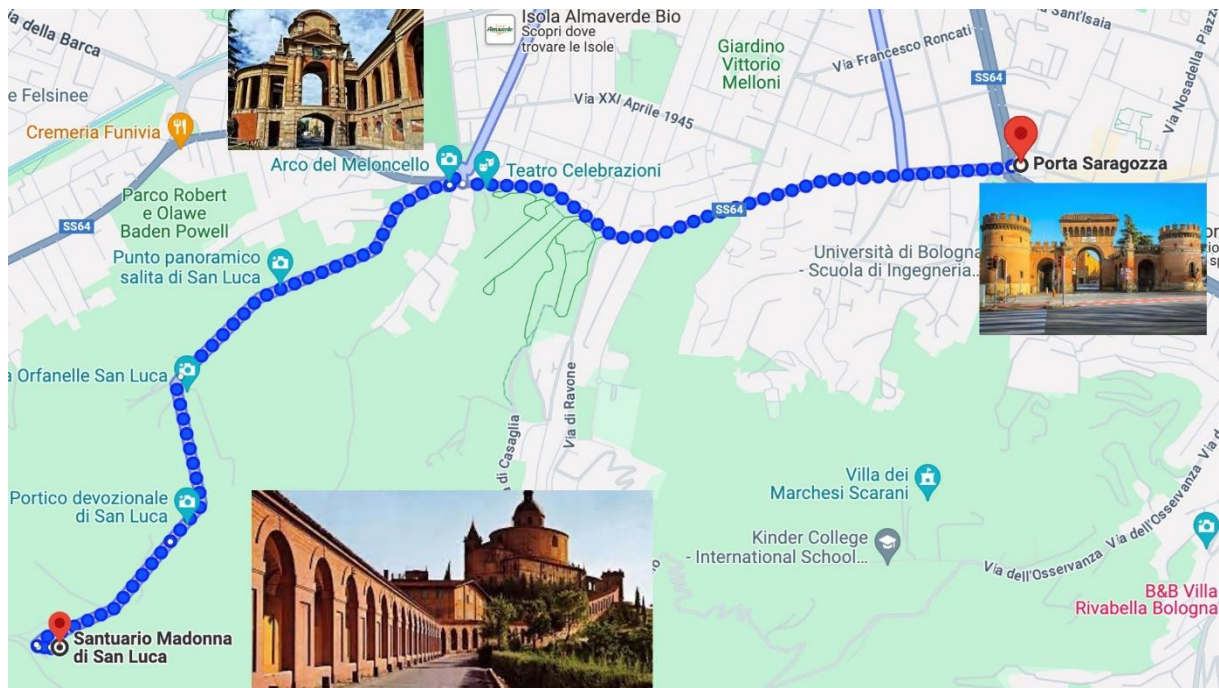
MAP #3 University district, conference & social events sites
