## Translated Summary

### CAMPUS VIBES Unibo Music Call RIMINI

Rimini Campus Day edition,  
10th of October 2019

Campus Vibes is the musical initiative aimed at identifying and promoting creative-musical skills among the students of the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna.

The selected participants of this second edition will be able to present their musical project during the “Rimini Campus Day” event, which will take place on Thursday 10th of Oct. 2019 at the Rimini Campus.

## Regulations

### WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

The initiative is addressed to students regularly enrolled at the Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna Degree Programs, who present own musical project before the expiry date of this regulation.

In case of bands: participation is allowed even if there is only one student regularly enrolled at the University of Bologna among the members.

Musicians who have: a contract, an editorial agreement or a record deal, will have to give their consent to the use of their songs using a specific written form, issued by the organization.

### HOW PARTICIPATE

To participate it is necessary to present two musical compositions, vocal or instrumental, interpreted without restrictions on style or musical genres, of unpublished or already published songs, or of covers in different languages or rearranged.

Registration to the musical call must be made by writing an e-mail to [campusrimini.orientamento@unibo.it](mailto:campusrimini.orientamento@unibo.it).

and indicating in the e-mail subject: “Campus Vibes” and also sending the following data:

- Surname, name, student number, degree program and phone number.

- Web Link to your song (Youtube, Soundcloud, etc) or send the two files in mp3 format.
- Link to a website with your artistic description or a description on a file with photo.
- Info about your musical project regarding your technical profile (number of persons, personal audio-technical equipment).

Registration is free of charge and it entails the respect and acceptance of the regulation.

## WHEN

Registration deadline: **Sunday 22 September 2019 at midnight.**

The selected participants will be contacted by e-mail or phone before the 30<sup>th</sup> of September 2019 to perform during the event “Rimini Campus Day”, scheduled for Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> of October 2019. The duration of each presentation will be agreed depending on the repertoire. Selected participants will participate for free/free of charge to the event.

## SELECTION

The selection process will be managed by a Jury made up of representatives of: the journalism-musical sector, the Rimini Campus representatives and the local student associations.

Exhibitions will be judged according to the following criteria:

- a) Artistic and composition value and quality
- b) Originality
- c) Interpretation capability.

## OPPORTUNITIES

Selected tracks and groups, further than playing during the “RiminiCampusDay” event, could have visibility on the Rimini Campus and Unibo institutional communication channels. The authors of the songs could be interviewed or invited to participate in local level broadcasts and could be selected for the itinerant music festival JustFor1Day 2019:

## TECHNICAL EQUIPMENT

The provided amplification equipment will be essential: for small dimension live shows (mixer, pre-amplified boxes, microphones). The possibility of multiple live stations placement will be evaluated. Participants will be responsible and handling for the Backline (instruments and amplifiers) and sound equipment. Moreover, assembly and dismantling will be responsibility of the participants. Participants must have and bring their own musical instruments as well as any added useful accessories.

The Rimini Campus doesn't assume any responsibility for materials, tools and personal items left unattended by the musicians participating in the contest live and / or by their accompanist. Technical details will be agreed after the selection.

## RESPONSABILITIES

Applications that do not comply with this regulation will be excluded.

Each participant, by registering to this musical call, relieves Alma Mater Studiorum - University of Bologna from any controversy related to: the songs, the performance and any conflicts over patrimonial rights.

The tracks must not contain offensive or against common morality contents.

## PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In compliance with the Italian Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 art. 13, and subsequent amendments and additions, the personal data, provided by the candidates through the applications, will be processed for the purposes related to the call.
